## **150 YEAR ANNIVERSARY CONCERTS**



## **BROMSGROVE STREET PASTORS**

Set up and operational since July 2012, Bromsgrove Street Pastors vigilantly patrolled the streets of the town each Friday night from 10pm until 4am Saturday morning, looking after people – mostly young – in many ways. The patrols were supported prayerfully at the base in the Baptist Church. Bromsgrove Street Pastors operated under the auspices of Churches Together in Bromsgrove with about 40 volunteers initially, mostly from the Free Churches although it was Rev Chris Wingfield, Vicar of St John's who brought the initiative into being.

At that time, Bromsgrove had a thriving Night Time Economy with many food outlets, pubs and the two nightclubs. However, with the onset of Covid 19 and all the attendant restrictions, the NTE was rapidly – possibly irreparably - reduced. At the same time, the number of Street Pastors declined to the point where it was beginning to be difficult to sustain patrols every Friday/Saturday or whether it would be possible to continue at all.

A meeting was called for 20 February to determine whether the initiative could be sustained. With much regret, and to the disappointment of the Police, the local authority and other interested parties, it was agreed that patrols would cease at the end of March. Much thought went into discussion of the future, especially trying to maintain the links which had been forged and to discern the Lord's will for the group going forward.

Please pray for the evolvement of our fellow Christians in this situation and make every effort to participate in the new process whatever that may be. As guide it has been suggested that;

- Continue to meet as a prayer team on Friday nights.
- Support the "Prayers for Bromsgrove" group that already meets monthly on a Monday. Contact Nicola Martin for more details and to be added to the email list (nicola.martin12@btinternet.com)

• Consider seeking the support of external groups skilled in bringing church and communities together to discern what the needs are locally, and take steps towards addressing them (see https://roc.uk.com/)

• Meet quarterly to pray and share updates of how the Lord is leading and guiding us into new areas / activities.

Let us hope that we can make a meaningful and purposeful contribution to this process.
